Closing Gala – Film + Party

Sunday 04 March

What time will the doors open?

The doors will open at 18:45. The audience should be seated by 19:15 at the latest.

What will be happening at the event in addition to the film screening?

Upon arrival, you will be offered a glass of complimentary drink and directed to your seat.

After the Closing Gala Film there is an after-party at the Old Fruitmarket (Candleriggs, Glasgow G1 1NQ).

When will the film end?

Nae Pasaran is 1 hour and 34 minutes long and will finish at approx. 21:15.

When will I be required to vacate the venue?

Once the film is finished, you will be asked to make your way to the Old Fruitmarket for the party. (see address below)

We recommend coming early if you are collecting pre-paid tickets on the night, as it can be very busy. Alternatively, you can collect your tickets from the GFT Box Office at any time after you have purchased them – which helps to avoid the busy periods.

Will you be selling tickets at the door?

If our event does not sell out, then tickets will be available to buy on the door. However, we have held similar events to this one before and they have nearly all sold out. We advise you to book your tickets as soon as possible. Ticket sales at the GFT Box Office end at 16:30 on the day of the event.

Where is the event taking place?

The event will be taking place at the Glasgow Film Theatre, and the party is taking place at the Old Fruitmarket, Glasgow City Halls, Candleriggs, Glasgow G1 1NQ.

Will there be alcohol for sale at the event?

Yes, there will be a licenced bar at GFT with a range of alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages.

You will also be offered a free glass of Prosecco upon arrival to GFT.

There will be a bar selling alcoholic and nonalcoholic drinks at the Old Fruitmarket.

Are there any age restrictions for this event?

The film is an N/C 8+ so nobody under 8 will be admitted. If you are lucky enough to look under 25 you will be asked to prove that you are aged 18 or over before receiving any drink tokens or buying alcohol.

Due to alcohol being served at the after party, no one under the age of 18 will be admitted.

Can I reserve a seat?

All seats in Cinema 1 are reserved by seat number. All other seats in Cinema 2+3 are unreserved, unless otherwise stated.

Are latecomers admitted?

Late entry to the cinema is at the discretion of the Event Coordinator. The Event Coordinator reserves the right of admission and their decision is final.

What is your refund policy?

Refunds will only be made in the case of cancellation of the event.
