### Divas, Despots and Dancing: Assunta Spina with Live Score

#### Where is the event taking place?

The event will be taking place at St Andrew's in the Square, 1 St Andrew's Square, Calton, Glasgow G1 5PP

#### What time will the doors open?

The doors will open at 19.00

#### What time will the live screenings actually start?

19.00 – Doors

19.30 – *Assunta Spina* with The Badwills

21.00 – The Badwills performance

22.15 – Ends\*

*\*all times approximate*

#### What will be happening at the event?

This event will comprise of a live score of the 1915 silent Italian film *Assunta Spina* live scored by the seven-piece Edinburgh band The Badwills followed by a live set by the band, with dancing encouraged.

#### When will the performances end?

The performances will finish at approximately 22.15.

#### Will you be selling tickets at the door?

If our event does not sell out, then tickets will be available to buy on the door. However, we have held similar events to this one before and they have nearly all sold out. We advise you to book your tickets as soon as possible.

Ticket sales at the GFT Box Office end at 17:00 on the day of the event. Ticket collection will be available at St Andrew's in the Square from 19:00 onwards.

#### Is this event seated or standing?

**Are there any age restrictions for this event?**

*Assunta Spina* is not BBFC certificated, however we recommend a 12 certificate for the film and will not admit anyone under 12 years of age to the event.

**Will there be alcohol for sale at the event?**

Yes, there will be licenced bars at St Andrews in the Square with a range of alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages. Challenge 25 checks will be in operation, If you are lucky enough to look under 25 you will be asked to prove that you are aged 18 or over before you are served alcohol.

**Are latecomers admitted?**

Late entry to the event is at the discretion of the venue and GFF Venue Coordinator.

**What is your refund policy?**

Refunds will only be made in the case of cancellation of the event.
