Film: *Fight Club*

Screening and Event at Parkhouse Business Park
Friday 1 March 2019

Where is the Parkhouse Business Park?

The Parkhouse Business Park is a warehouse complex situated on 419 Balmore Road, Glasgow, G22 6NU, just across the street from the Possilpark & Parkhouse train station.

Once at the entrance of the Parkhouse Business Park, walk straight down towards Block 2, and the location is on the right hand side (within Block 2 silver building) in Unit 6.

There will be GFF branding displayed to guide you along the way, as well as volunteers to direct you towards the location.

What time will the event start?

The doors will open in **Block 2 Unit 6** at **18:00**.

What time will the film actually start?

Fight Club will be screened from 19:30. Audiences should take their seats approx. 10 minutes prior to film start time.

When will the film end?

Fight Club is 2 hour and 19 minutes long and will finish at approximately 22:00.

What will be happening at the event in addition to the film screening?

The doors will open for the event in Block 2 Unit 6 at 18:00. The event will feature performers roaming around the area and interacting with audiences, as well as fight reenactments. The event will also feature a pop up bar where you can purchase alcoholic and non alcoholic drinks, and a graffiti area where you can watch a professional graffiti artist create a special artwork inspired by the event.

Please ensure you have cash available with you for the event, as there is no ATM point nearby the event venue.

Will the performance be dangerous?

The staff involved in the performance are all trained professionals, and they will be re-enacting a previously rehearsed routine. Every step has been taken to ensure health and safety for both public and performers during this event, and we kindly ask all audiences to:

- Please refrain from trying to join the fight performance, or trying to distract the performers in any way, as this could result in harm and injuries to performers and / or yourself.
- We kindly ask all audience members to listen to, and comply with the instructions given by our event stewards, who are there to ensure everyone's safety.
- If you are asked to move or clear a performance area, please do so while also being mindful of the people next to you.

- Due to stage blood being used for the fight performance, please be aware that being close to the fight performance may result in stage blood on clothing and or skin. This is washable, but if you would rather avoid this, then please keep a safer distance from the fight performance.
- Please note that there will be prop weapons used within this performance. As these weapons are fake and non-functional they pose no risk to the performers or the audience members.

How will the access be managed?

Wristbands will be distributed upon arrival and will need to be worn at all times during the event. Please only remove the wristband when you are leaving at the end of the event, as our staff and volunteers have been instructed to block access to any event area to anyone not wearing a wristband.

When will I be required to vacate the venue?

The audience will be asked to leave at the end of the film screening, by 22:15 the very latest.

Will the venue be heated?

Please note that even though there will be heaters available, you will be spending the duration of the event inside industrial warehouses, so it might still get chilly. We strongly advise you to layer up warm, keep hats, fluffy socks, scarves and gloves handy, and opt for warm flat-soled shoes.

Tickets sales and collection are available from Glasgow Film Theatre Box Office up until 16:00 on Friday 28 February, after which they can be collected from Parkhouse Business Park (Block 2 Unit 6) **from 18:00**.

There will be no ticket collection facilities available at the venue before 18:00.

Will you be selling tickets at the door?

If our event does not sell out, then tickets will be available to buy on the door. However, we have held similar events to this one before and they have nearly all sold out. We advise you to book your tickets as soon as possible.

Where is the event taking place?

The event will be taking place at Parkhouse Business Park Block 2 Unit 6 (419 Balmore Road, G22 6NU). The doors will open at **18:00**.

Will there be alcohol for sale at the event?

Yes, there will be a licenced bar selling a range of alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages. You will not be allowed to bring other alcohol into the event. Not complying will result in the alcohol being confiscated, and you being asked to leave the event.

Please ensure you have cash available with you for the event, as there is no ATM point nearby.

Will there be food for sale at the event?

Yes, there will be a food stand selling food, including meat and vegetarian options.

Are there any age restrictions for this event?

Fight Club is a certificate 18, so no one under 18 will be admitted. If you are lucky enough to look under 25 you will be asked to prove that you are aged 18 or over before you are given access to the event.

In addition, please note there will be security on the premises who will be checking for valid identification and conducting bag checks. Please be aware that any alcohol brought to this event will be confiscated and may result in you being asked to leave the event.

What will the toilets be like at the venue?

There will be portable toilet units available throughout the event.

Will there be a smoking area?

Smoking, vaping or use of e-cigarettes will not be allowed anywhere inside the venue. If you are not sure where the smoking area is, one of our GFF Volunteers will be happy to direct you. Please be aware that if you do not follow these rules, this may result in you being asked to leave the event.

Can I reserve a seat?

All seats are unreserved, unless otherwise stated.

Are latecomers admitted?

Late entry to the event is at the discretion of the Event Manager. The Event Manager reserves the right of admission and their decision is final.

What is your refund policy?

Refunds will only be made in the case of cancellation of the event.
