Opening Gala: Mid90s + After Party Wednesday 20 February

What time will the doors open?

The Glasgow Film Theatre doors will open at 18:30.
Audience should be seated by 19:20.

What will be happening at the event in addition to the film screening?

Upon arrival, you will be offered a voucher that can be exchanged for a glass of prosecco or a non alcoholic drink and directed to your seat.

After the Opening Gala Film, you will be able to join our after party at 29 Glasgow (29 Royal Exchange Square, Glasgow G1 3AJ).

When will the film end?

Mid90s is approx. 1 hour and 25 minutes long and will finish at approx at 20:55.

When will I be required to vacate the venue?

Once the film is finished, you will be asked to make your way to 29 Glasgow for the after party.

Where can I collect my tickets from?

We recommend coming early if you are collecting pre-paid tickets on the night, as it can be very busy. Alternatively, you can collect your tickets from the GFT Box Office at any time after you have purchased them – which helps to avoid the busy periods.

Will you be selling tickets at the door?

If our event does not sell out, then tickets will be available to buy on the door. However, we have held similar events to this one before and they have nearly all sold out. We advise you to book your tickets as soon as possible.

The film will be screening at the Glasgow Film Theatre (12 Rose St, Glasgow G3 6RB) and the after party will be taking place at 29 Glasgow (29 Royal Exchange Square, Glasgow G1 3AJ).

Will there be alcohol for sale at the event?

Yes, there will be a licenced bar at GFT selling a range of alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages. You will also be offered one voucher which can be exchanged for a glass of prosecco or a non alcoholic drink upon arrival.

Are there any age restrictions for this event?

The Opening Gala: *Mid90's* is certified *N/C 18+* and no one under 18 will be admitted due to alcohol being served at the location. If you are lucky enough to look under 25 you will be asked to prove that you are aged 18 or over before receiving any drink tokens or buying alcohol.

Will there be food at the event?

There will be snacks available to purchase at the bar in GFT.

Can I reserve a seat?

All seats in Cinema 1 are reserved by seat number. All other seats in Cinema 2 and 3 are unreserved, unless otherwise stated.

Are latecomers admitted?

Late entry to the cinema is unlikely to be permitted, please arrive promptly. Entry may be permitted in exceptional cases at the discretion of the Duty Manager. The Duty Manager reserves the right of admission and their decision is final.

What is your refund policy?

Refunds will only be made in the case of cancellation of the event.
